Case Study #1 – AT Category: Hearing (HAAT)

Human – A person who is deaf; uses ASL, lip reading, and written communication

Activity – Utilization Rehab Services to enter the workforce

Assistive Technology – Does the employee already have access to tools? Cell phone, Video Relay telephone, access to ASL services through VR.

Written Notes - Lip Reading - two-way texting - video relay phone -- CART
