Activity – working as a chef

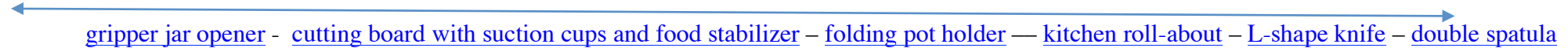
Assistive Technology – needs AT to assist with food preparation

STE

P 1: Based on S-E-T data, enter descriptors or functions needed by the student across the shaded top row - 1 descriptor per column

STEP 2: Enter promising tools in the shaded left column - 1 tool per row

STEP 3: Note whether each tool matches a descriptor by placing an “X” in each of the applicable white boxes
